The Morris Museum is a major cultural center and travel destination for the arts, sciences and humanities. Permanent displays include rocks, minerals, fossils, animal mounts, a model railroad, and Native American crafts, pottery, carving, basketry and textiles. Pass admits 2 adults plus 3 children in same household. *Sorry, the Morris Museum does not participate in a reciprocal program.*
